












	Steps			Inside or Outside			Tools/ Parts Needed for Installation
1	Unboxing the Zebra Blinds:	Start by removing the Staples and lifting the lid of the box containing your new zebra blinds. (Remove Protective Film when installation is complete)					Tools: Power Drill, Drill Bit, Screwdriver, Pencil, Hammer, Measuring Tape
2	Measurement and Marking:	Measure and mark approximately three inches on each side of the window. While it doesn't need to be precise, ensure consistency on both sides. Mark the locations where the holes for brackets will be drilled.					 Outside Mount Bracket
3	Drilling Holes:	Utilize a power drill to create holes at the marked locations. This is where the brackets will be secured.					 Screw and Anchor
4	Inserting Anchors:	Hammer in the anchors into the holes you drilled. This provides a stable foundation for the brackets.					 Clip
5	Bracket Installation:	Screw in the brackets, ensuring they are firmly secured. You can use either a screwdriver or a drill for this step.					Twist clip onto outside mount bracket, clip in blind
6	Attaching Zebra Blinds:	Snap the zebra blinds into place on the installed brackets. Confirm that they are securely attached if desired for child safety install cord clip with screw and anchor and adjust cord					 Child safety clip
